The warning stated "The allied governments announce publicly that they hold all the members of the Ottoman Government, as well as such of their agents as are implicated, personally responsible for such matters." Was it preventable? Yes. The Turkish only didn't like the Armenians because they were Christians.

### Aftermath( How the genocide affected the families)

The effects on victims and families were families died, newborns were born with a disability. They couldn't care for their kids. The victims felt abandoned and had nothing. They lived in poverty and despair. The country today in the last few years Turkish military officers has been captured and imprisoned including the ex-chief of defense.
