Failure of appeasement

- The Munich Agreement Agreed that the Sudetenland would be returned to Germany and that no further territorial claims would be made by Germany.
- When Hitler invaded the rest of Czechoslovakia in March 1939, he broke the terms if the agreement



Failure of the League of Nations

- The League of Nations was an international organization set up in 1919 to keep world peace.
- The Great Depression hurt the ability of the League of Nations because countries did not want to risk losing trade and did not agree to requests.
