Motives (reasons)

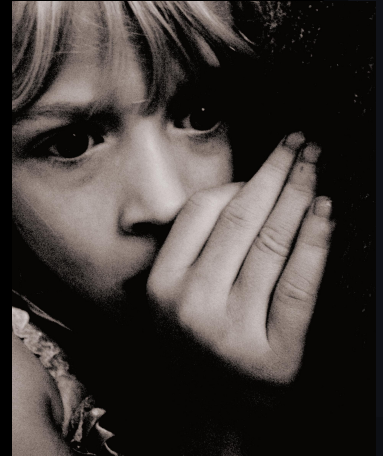
The ottoman empire was in serious decline, they had a discriminatory system and they wanted to get rid of the armenian population.
