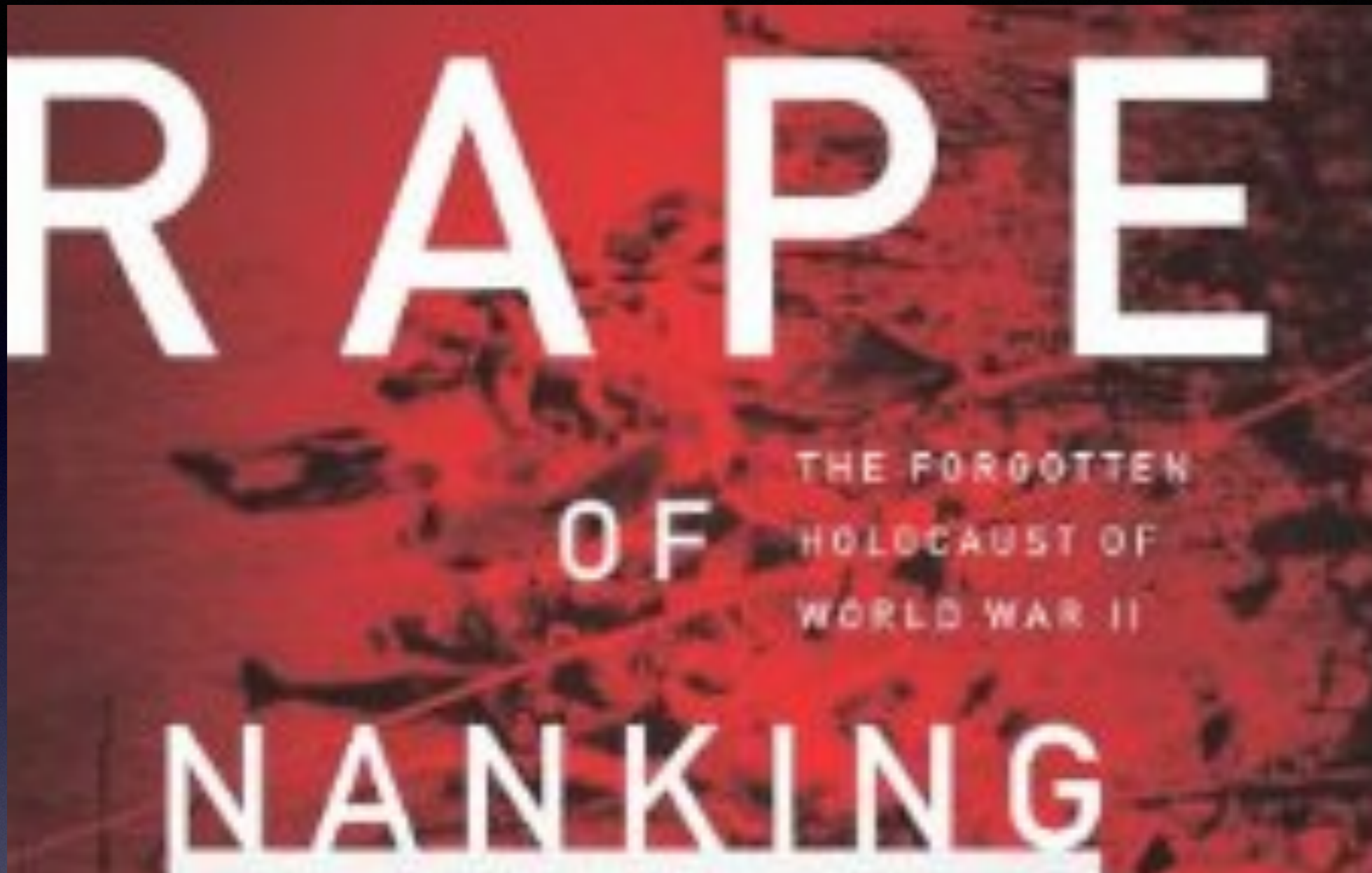


# 20th century genocide project
