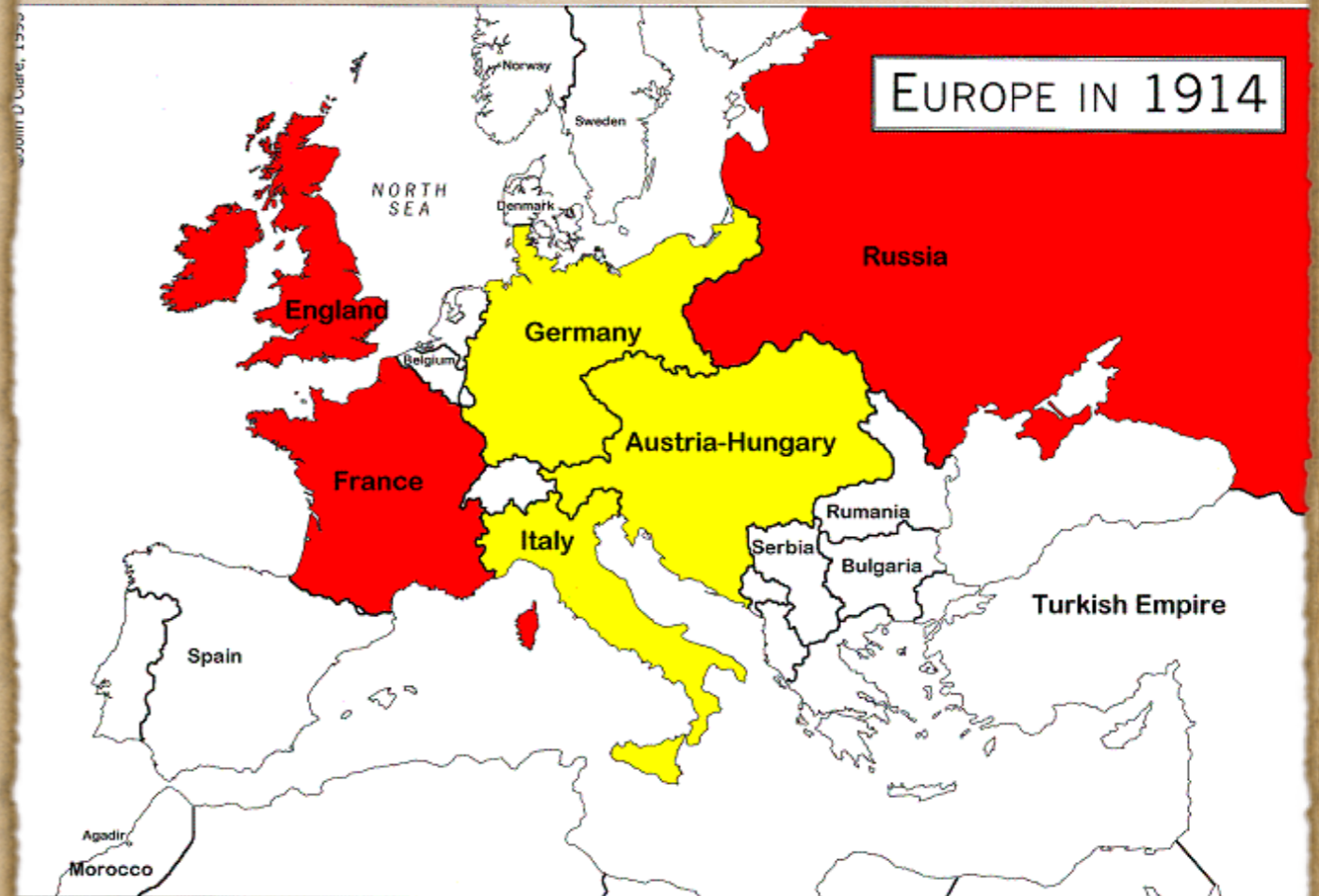

Political

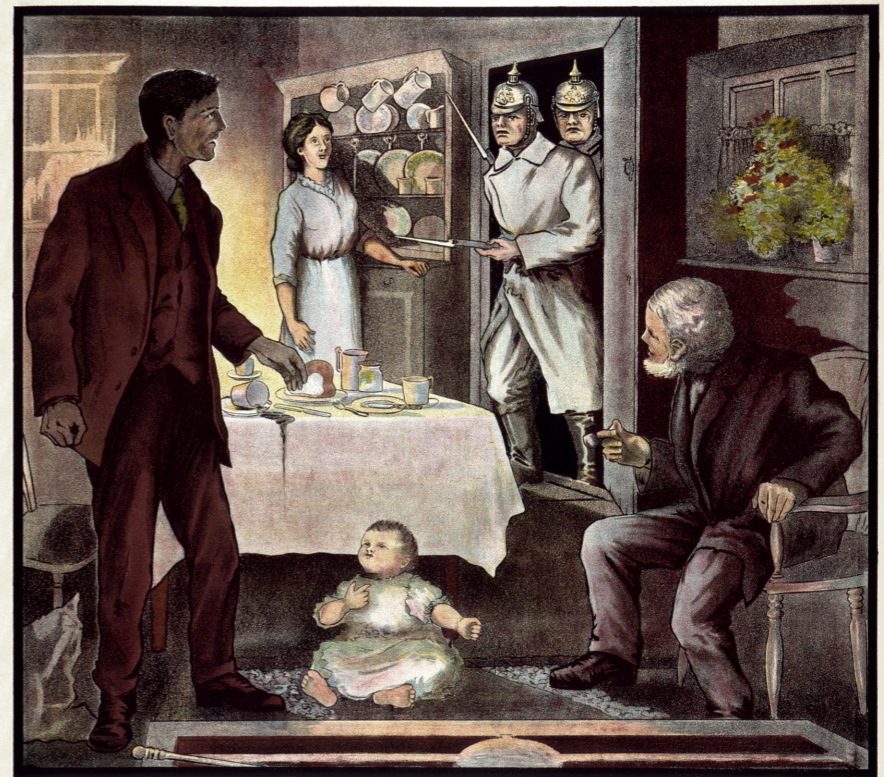
- ◆ Political motives were based on nations desire to gain power, to compete with other European countries, to expand territory, to exercise military force, to gain prestige by winning colonies, and to boost national pride and security.



Economic

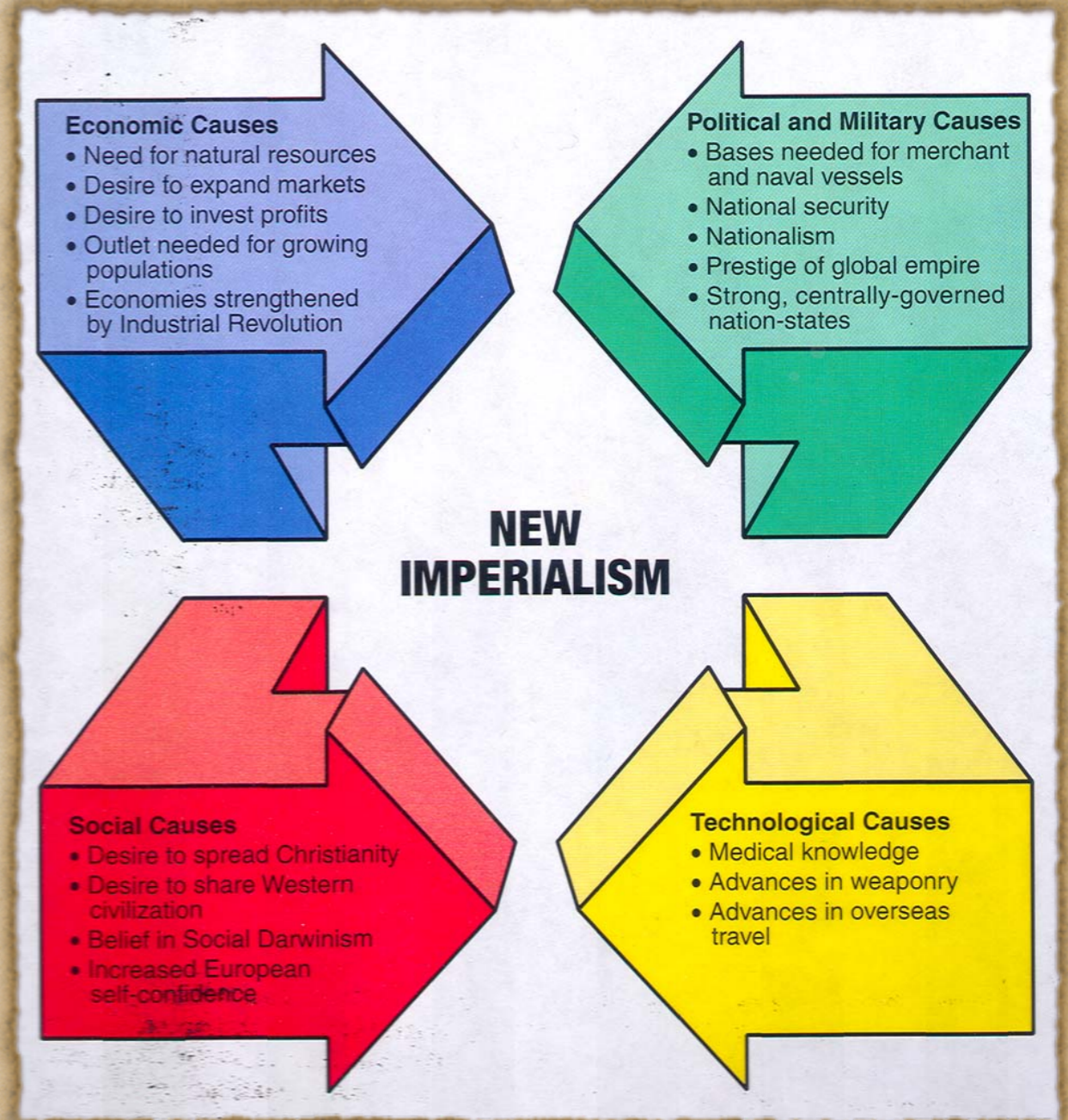
